EGD & ERCP Instructions

- You <u>MUST HAVE A DRIVER</u> the day of your procedure because you will be getting anesthesia that day.
- STOP taking all aspirin & blood thinning agents <u>3 DAYS PRIOR</u> to the procedure. This includes some Vitamins (i.e. Gingko, E). If you are a HEART PATIENT, let the doctor know immediately for alternate instructions. All other medications/vitamins may be taken as prescribed.
- The day before your procedure, you will eat & drink normally EXCEPT THAT
 <u>YOU WILL NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT</u> BECAUSE OF
 THE ANESTHESIA! ANYTHING CONSUMED THE MORNING OF THE
 PROCEDURE WOULD PRESENT A CHOKING DANGER! * * * *
 - * * * *IF YOUR APPOINTMENT IS **AFTER 1:30PM**, YOU MAY HAVE **CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY UNTIL 9:00AM!!**
- Unless the doctor tells you otherwise, & you are a patient on blood pressure medicine. (& take your meds in the morning), you may take it NO LATER THAN 3 HOURS PRIOR to the procedure WITHOUT LIQUIDS! Let the Anesthetist on duty know if you took your meds during your interview with them. All afternoon medications can wait until then to be taken.
- If you are an **ASTHMA PATIENT**, **bring your inhalers to the procedure** with you & **inform the Anesthetist**.

Remember: NO DRIVING OR WORKING FOR 24 HOURS AFTER!
